**OBJECTIVES**

- Study the different animals not pets that live in the city.
- Observe the different ways of life and how they get adapted to the environment.
- Develop their investigation ability.

**MATERIAL**

Binoculars, magnifying glass, pincers, CAPSULA DE PETRI, rubber gloves, plastic bags.

**INTRODUCTION**

Although the action of man has transformed completely the natural surrounding of the city, certain animals that aren't pets have managed to get adapted to urban areas.

Are we capable of discovering them?

**PROCEDIMENT:**

- 1- For the invertebrates (ants, beetles and other insects): You have pincers, different jars where to put them and a magnifying glass to look inside.
  - a) Where do they live?
  - b) What do they use from men? Where do they get their food?
- 2- For the vertebrates (birds, mice, etc.) you have binoculars to locate the different bird species and some paper bags, gloves and a magnifying glass to examine and identify the possible remains. If you find their nests, observe how they are made and with the help of the compass try to find out the entrance direction. Write these details in the worksheet comments section.
  - a) Where do they live?
  - b) What do they use from men? Where do they take their food?

If you study alive animals, don't forget to return them unharmed to the place where you found them, once you have observed them.
